Administrative Support

Volunteers are needed to staff our reception desk. If you have any customer service or reception experience, or are good at answering phones, we could use your help!

Energy Assistance Program

Volunteers with experience with filing and typing, or with the willingness to learn those skills, are needed to assist our Energy Assistance program. Flexible individuals are needed to help with a variety of additional tasks.

GED (HiSET) Tutoring

Volunteer tutors are needed to assist in the educational journey of students working toward their HiSET/GED for employment or continuing their education.

Head Start

Head Start is funded 80% by a grant from the Department of Health and Human Services. The remaining 20% must come from local support of the program. You can volunteer your time, your work, your knowledge, and your skills.

Housing and Weatherization Programs

Volunteers are needed to assist with clerical duties, and with answering the phones for our Housing and Weatherization programs.

Life Skills Training
